How to apply for a Schengen visa

Citizens of countries requiring a visa must possess a visa to enter and stay in the Schengen Area.

Information on entry requirements: www.sem.admin.ch.

To apply for a Schengen visa, the following is required:

- 1. The inviting person:
 - draws up an **invitation letter** stating **who** (name of person/s), for **what duration** (max. 3 months) and for what **purpose** (holiday, family visit etc.) is being invited (*there are no templates from the City of Bern*);
 - creates a copy of a valid identity document (passport, ID, foreign national identity document);
 - obtains up-to-date payslips for the last 90 days;
 - obtains an **up-to-date account statement (bank or post office)** with account history for the last 90 days;
 - sends the above documents to the person wishing to enter Switzerland.
- 2. The person wishing to enter Switzerland must **arrange** an **appointment** by **telephone** with the Swiss embassy in their place of residence.

- 3. The above documents must be presented to the embassy on the agreed date. The embassy decides whether or not a declaration of commitment is required.
- 4. If a declaration of commitment is required, follow the next steps on the **declaration of commitment checklist**.
